In January 2009 Cowling Enterprises was awarded a Commercial Façade Grant by the Merritt Island Redevelopment Agency (MIRA) for exterior enhancements to Hurwood Plaza North, Hurwood Plaza South and the Cowling Eye Center located on North Courtenay Parkway. The Grant requires Cowling Enterprises to expend at least \$30,000 to receive the \$15,000 grant upon project completion.
