Thank you for your interest in the Brevard County Low Income Home Assistance Program Energy (LIHEAP). You must fall into one of these categories to be given priority during the first week of the month.

ELDERLY: Must be at least sixty (60) years old.

DISABLED: Must be receiving disability benefits from either Social Security or employer/insurance disability benefits.

HOUSEHOLDS WITH CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF FIVE (5): Must provide Birth Certificates for children five (5) years old or younger.

APPROVED FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY PARTICIPANTS: Actively participating in the Family Self-Sufficiency Program.

You will need to complete the enclosed application and return it with the following information listed below. Please also see the attached.

- Completed application (Note: on the first page of the application, the column next to name asks for applicant number, this is your social security number. This must be completed in order to process application).**
- Florida Drivers License or Florida Identification Card for all adult household members with a Brevard County Address.**
- Original Social Security Cards for all household members.**
- Birth Certificates for all children that are listed on the application.**
- Verification of all household income for the past twelve (12) months. If you are receiving Unemployment Compensation Benefits you will need to call (954) 625-3009 for a payment history for the past twelve months. If you are receiving Social Security, SSI, SSD, Pension, Alimony, Annuity, AFDC/TANF, Retirement, Workman's Comp, VA, Child Support, or Etc. you need to provide a current printout for the past twelve months. If you are receiving Wages you will need to provide your Income Tax Return and Paycheck Stubs for the past 12 months.**
- Copy of electric/gas energy bill.**
