**Location:** The Survey & Mapping Office is located at the County Government Center, Suite A-220, 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way, Viera, FL 32940

**Key Responsibilities**

Work with County Survey Crews operating digital equipment used to observe/measure land and spatial relationships; learn about GIS Asset mapping as it relates to surveying and mapping

**Qualifications**

- No experience necessary – on the job training will be provided by Survey and Mapping staff
- Able to work outside in a variety of seasonal weather conditions and locations throughout Brevard County
- On occasion, lift up to 50 pounds; walk long distances; carry up to 25 pounds of equipment or on occasion be exposed to traffic conditions
- Must possess valid Florida drivers' license
- In-person meeting with County Surveyor
- Able to pass low level background screening including driving history record check
- Excellent work ethic

**Time Commitment:** A minimum of two – eight hour day each week is required. The Survey Field Crews' workday schedule is 6:30am to 3pm with ½ hour lunch.

**Training & Support:** Training and support provided by Survey & Mapping staff, including, but not limited to operation of GPS equipment Total Stations, digital levels, and various other tools such as hand tools, machetes, and chainsaws

**Benefits:** Gain valuable, real-world experience in the Surveying & Mapping Profession; enhance your skills, knowledge and job qualification and apply classroom knowledge and skills in a professional setting.

Staff will work with students in order to meet requirements for college internship credit for the following programs: Civil Engineering, Urban & Regional Planning, Construction Management, Agriculture Management, or Environmental Sciences.
