Summary Explanation & Background:

**Mission Statement:**  
 Review the operation of each County Department and Charter Office, and work with county personnel to reduce costs, seek alternative solutions to solving problems and provide the County Commissioners with new and innovative opportunities for delivery of services and maximum utilization of county resources.

**Purpose:**  
 The Efficiency Commission shall conduct a comprehensive study of government in Brevard County, including Charter Officers, and the organization, structure, effectiveness and efficiency of any board, officer, authority, agency, division, department or other unit of government included within the budget approved by the Board of County Commissioners, and State Legislature. The study shall include an examination and an analysis of the most effective and cost-efficient manner for organizational effectiveness and asset utilization, and may include consideration of private delivery of services and ways in which to coordinate effective and efficient delivery of services and utilization of assets, by, between and among governmental units, including municipalities and the School District
