BREVARD COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION

SUBJECT: Proposed Charter Amendment to schedule a vote for the 2012 General election asking the voters if they want to repeal the Brevard County Charter

PETITIONER: Al Yorston

Requested Action:

Requesting the Charter Review Commission consider approval of a Charter Amendment asking the voters to schedule a vote in November of 2012 to repeal the Charter and return Brevard to a Constitutional form of government.

Summary Explanation & Background:

This proposal relates to the approval of an amendment to the Brevard County Charter under the process outlined for the adoption of amendments by the Charter Review Commission. This proposal requests that the Charter Review Commission approve an amendment to be placed on the ballot in 2010 Amending the Charter to require a vote in November of 2012 asking the voters if the Brevard County Charter should be repealed and Brevard return to a Constitutional form of government. Proposed ballot language includes: "Shall the Brevard County Charter be amended to require a vote scheduled for the 2012 General Election asking the voters to repeal the Brevard County Charter?"

This proposal is not an endorsement of repealing the Charter nor is it asking the Charter Review Commission to support repealing the Charter, this proposal simply requests to place the question before the citizens of Brevard County and schedule a vote for the 2012 General Election for the voter's consideration.
