**AGENDA REPORT**  
*BREVARD COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION*

SUBJECT: Section 4.1 Elected County Officers

PETITIONER: Dale Young

Requested Action:

Convert Constitutional Offices to County Offices under the control of the County Charter.

Summary Explanation & Background:

The Constitutional Offices of Sheriff, Property Appraiser, Clerk of Courts, Tax Collector, and Supervisor of Elections are abolished and their duties are transferred to the re-established charter officers of Brevard County as the county offices of Sheriff, Property Appraiser, Clerk of Courts, Tax Collector, and Supervisor of Elections under Article VII, Section 1(d), of the Constitution of the State of Florida. This revision is to take effect January 1, 2012. The holders of the former constitutional offices of Sheriff, Property Appraiser, Clerk of Courts, Tax Collector, and Supervisor of Elections shall be retained as the initial officers for the re-established offices. Referenced offices, except as may be specifically set forth by in the Charter, shall be governed by the Constitution, and laws of the State of Florida, under Article VIII, Section 1(d), of the Florida Constitution.  
 Effective upon passage elections 2010.
