

Coastal Tech Disclaimer to Appendix C:

At the request of Brevard County, Coastal Tech agreed to include ASR America in the preparation of this Feasibility Study. ASR America has contributed to this Feasibility Study under the auspices of a sub-contract with Coastal Tech relative to:

- the literature review - Section 2.1 & Sub-Appendix C1
- the proposed ASR Configuration – as designed and proposed by ASR America
- Conceptual Design – (a) portions of Sections 4 and 5, and (b) Sub-Appendix C3 and Sub-Appendix C4.

The remaining sub-appendices have been provided by ASR America beyond the scope of the ASR America sub-contract with Coastal Tech.

As identified in the sub-contract, Coastal Tech agreed to include ASR America's work products in this Appendix C. Coastal Tech has included contributions of ASR America within the main body of this Feasibility Study where such contributions are considered by Coastal Tech to be appropriate and pertinent to the Feasibility Study.
