Assoc. spp. Sabal palmetto, Acer rubrum, Osmunda regalis,
Acrosticum danaeifolium

Description: Herb to 2.5 ft. with white tubular flowers and
black stamens; leaves rough, simple, or 3 lobed

Abundance: Common

Soil: Hydric
