**In addition to the above information, it is the responsibility of the applicant or the authorized agent to provide this Office with clear and convincing evidence that the activity proposed will not:**

- Adversely impact water quality.
- Result in the loss of shoreline and aquatic vegetation.
- Adversely affect adjacent properties.
- Adversely affect biological communities.
- Increase the waterward extension of the existing shoreline, except where bulkheads must be parallel and in line with adjacent bulkheads.
- Adversely affect the flow of water or create a navigational hazard.

**Per Section 62-3666(13) all improvements, mitigations, and special conditions approved shall be required to be installed, constructed, and maintained in a viable, approved, functional working order.** All applicants shall be subject to and responsible for obtaining all additional necessary permits, prior to local approval. State or federal approval of shoreline hardening shall not exempt the applicant from local approval or denial of the project. All appeals of decisions of the Natural Resources Management Office shall be subject to the provisions of Section 62-3665 of the Brevard County Code.
