Frequently Asked Questions

Q – Why is the census done?

A – Agencies use the information to apply for grants. If the census is not conducted, several agencies will lose their funding. The information is also used by the Brevard Continuum of Care Coalition to help agencies and individuals understand the needs of the homeless and where those needs are greatest in our County.

Q - How long are the shifts?

A – Shifts are two hours or longer, you decide how much time you wish to spend on the census.

Q – What are the hours?

A – The Census is from 5:00 am until 8:00 pm. You decide when you can volunteer. Greatest needs are early morning and lunch time.

Q – What do we do on the Census day?

A – At the Census Volunteer Center (Holy Trinity Episcopal Church) you will receive census forms, bags of socks, shirts, and other items. You will be assigned areas to conduct the census. Groups of two or more are assigned per area.
