Brevard County Farmers Market Adds New Vendors

MELBOURNE, Fla. – New locally produced items for the Brevard County Farmers Market include organic produce, homemade pickles, sweet potato butter, fresh-baked bread, and sausage. Deep-root grass-fed beef will be available March 11.

The Brevard County Farmers Market is held at the Wickham Park Equestrian Center in Melbourne every Thursday from 3 to 7 p.m., co-sponsored by the University of Florida Brevard County Extension Service and Brevard County Parks and Recreation.

The farmers market features a wide variety of locally grown and produced fresh tomatoes, organic citrus, micro-greens, pasta sauce, eggs, meat pies, quiche, wing sauce, fudge, native plants, honey, herbals, dog treats, homemade soap, and more.

The Brevard County UF/IFAS Extension Master Gardeners also sell fully constructed rain barrels at the market for \$50, allowing the collection of rainwater for use in landscapes.
