**“Stormwater 101” Presentations Offered**

BREVARD COUNTY, Fla. – “Stormwater 101” presentations will be held at public libraries throughout Brevard County in August and September.

Elizabeth Melvin of the Brevard County Natural Resources Management Office will outline actions residents can take to minimize stormwater pollution. She will provide an overview of how stormwater pollution affects water quality, what water quality standards are required by the Clean Water Act for the Indian River Lagoon, and what local governments are doing to improve water quality in the Indian River Lagoon and St. Johns River.
