ENCHANTED FOREST TO HOST VARIETY OF FREE EVENTS

TITUSVILLE, Fla. – The Enchanted Forest Sanctuary Management & Education Center in Titusville will host a variety of free events throughout the month of August.

On Wednesday, August 4 at 9:30 a.m., a butterfly hike will be held along the gardens and trails.

On Thursdays, August 5 and 19 from 10 a.m. to noon, visitors can have an up-close encounter with a live gopher tortoise, and learn about how this threatened species and its habitats are connected to humans.

On Friday, August 6 at 9:30 a.m., Nature for Little Ones will include stories, puppets and songs for infants to pre-K. The topic this month is lizards.

On Tuesday, August 10 and Friday, August 20 from noon to 2 p.m., oyster mat making will take place, assisting the Nature Conservancy with their project of restoring oyster reefs in the Mosquito Lagoon.

On Sunday, August 15 from 2 to 4 p.m., a Forest Funday will be held for children of all ages. There will be games, nature activities, arts and crafts, native wildlife, and more.

On Saturday, August 21 from 9 to 11 a.m., the Friends of the Enchanted Forest photography club will meet to share information and photos. All skill levels are welcome.

The Enchanted Forest Sanctuary is located at 444 Columbia Boulevard (SR405), a half-mile west of US1 in Titusville. There is no cost to attend any of the events. For more information, call (321) 264-5185.
