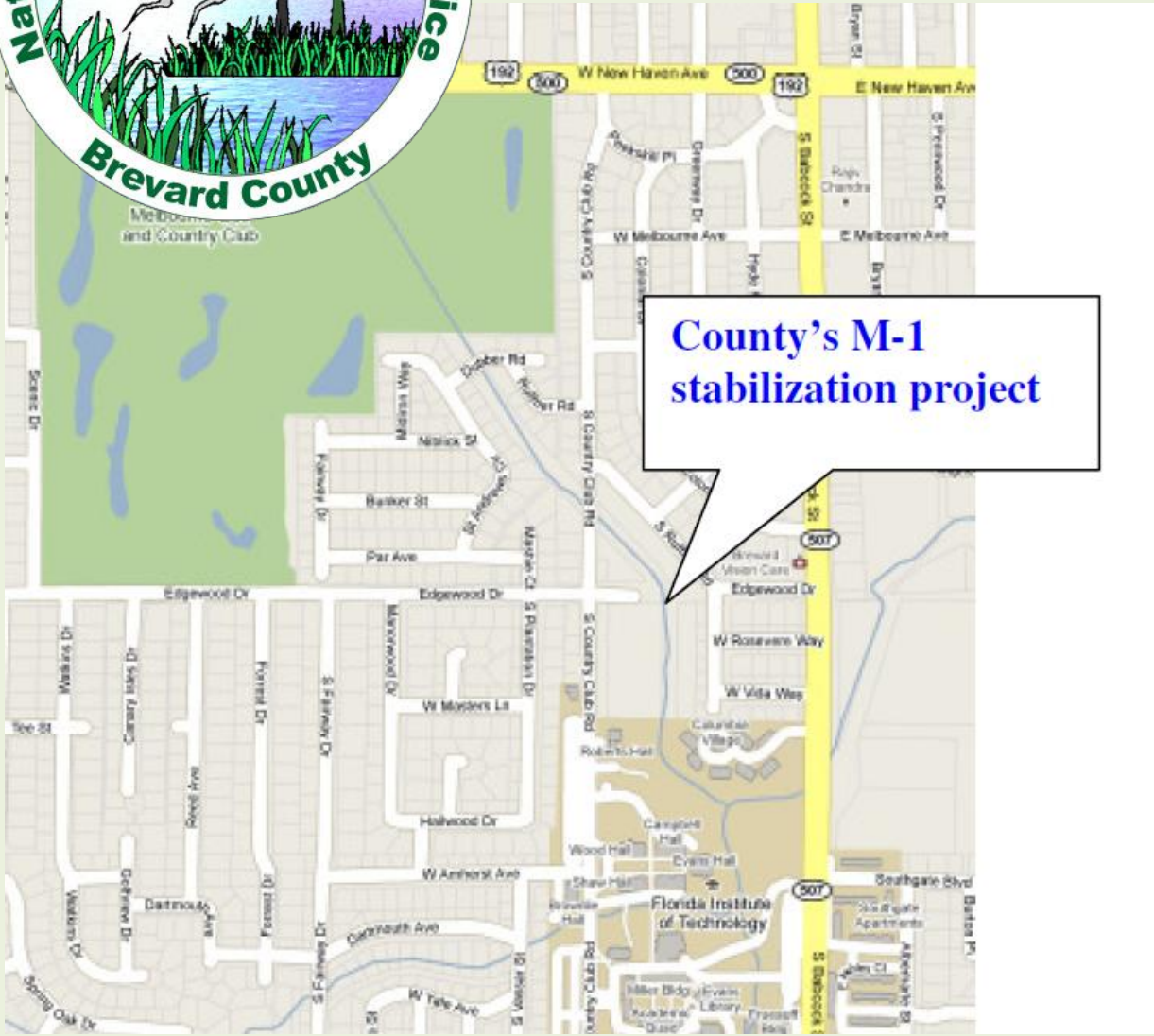




M-1 CANAL STABILIZATION



This project consists of reconstructing and lining approximately 300 feet of the M-1 Canal where severe erosion is occurring. This project will prevent continued erosion of this section of the M-1 Canal, which is a major source of turbidity and muck in the lower Crane Creek, a tributary to the Indian River Lagoon. An additional two-chamber separating baffle box will control surface runoff from a dirt parking area. Construction began in July 2010 and is expected to be complete in December, 2010.
