

## **RESOLUTION NO. 04-173**

WHEREAS, Chapter 403.76, Florida Statutes, requires that Brevard County plan and implement an efficient and environmentally acceptable solid waste management program to handle solid waste generated within the County and to provide for reduction in the amount of said solid waste disposed of at the County's solid waste management facilities through the implementation of a recycling program; and

WHEREAS, the statewide goal of the Solid Waste Management Act of 1988 is to reduce the amount of municipal solid waste being disposed of at the solid waste management facility by at least 30 percent by 1994; and

WHEREAS, the act requires counties to develop and implement recycling programs within their jurisdictions to return valuable materials to productive use, to conserve energy and natural resources, and to protect capacity at solid waste management facilities; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 1989, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners approved the Brevard County Recycling Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to bring to the recycling process a broad range of expertise as well as the views of the community at large; and

WHEREAS, a Recycling Citizen Advisory Committee consisting of members of the Brevard County Community would allow for additional detailed input on the recycling activities by the citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes the Committee to reconvene for the purpose of assessing the implementation of previously approved recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The Recycling Citizens Advisory Committee (RCAC) shall reconvene to assess the implementation of the previously approved recommendations.
2. The RCAC shall be comprised of nine members: one appointee from each County Commission District; one member-at-large to be appointed by the Board, three members appointed by the League of Cities, and one member by the School Board. It is also recommended that ex-officio, non-voting members representing private sector collection of recyclables, processing of recyclables, and marketing of recyclables as identified by the Solid Waste Management Department be invited to participate on the Committee. The Solid Waste Recycling Coordinator shall serve as liaison to the Committee.

3. They shall submit a written report of their findings to the Board of Commissioners no later than February 2005.
4. The reconvened RCAC will sunset on February 28, 2005.

The RCAC shall comply with all open governmental laws.

This resolution will take effect August 10, 2004.
