****DEFINITION OF "TREATED WOOD" (CCA) – any wood treated with a chemical to protect the wood from rotting due to insects and microbial agents. Treated wood - typically generated by deck, dock and fence contractors.***

WOOD ITEMS TYPICALLY TREATED WITH CCA

Lumber, timber and plywood with green color
Wood fences, docks, decks, stairs and posts
Wood 4" x 4" diameter or larger
Dimensional lumber with end tags/labels
Wood from playground equipment
Lumber used in landscaping flowerbeds, garden, etc.
Utility poles and railroad ties
