WOOD ITEMS TYPICALLY TREATED WITH CCA*

Lumber, timber and plywood with green color

Wood fences, docks, decks, stairs and posts

Wood 4" x 4" diameter or larger

Dimensional lumber with end tags/labels

Wood from playground equipment

Lumber used in landscaping flowerbeds, garden, etc.

Utility poles and railroad ties
